Several representatives of the veterans' community in Potter County attended the meeting to ask the commissioners to set a timeline for the creation and filling of a second full-time position in the County Director of Veterans Services offices. Spokesmen discussed the need to expedite the process, as the number and complexity of veterans' claims continue to rise based on new federal legislation and other factors.

Coudersport Volunteer Fire Dept. Chief Bryan Phelps requested county support to address issues related to 911 dispatching. He noted that there us duplication and inconsistency with some road/street names and numbers, while acknowledging that townships and boroughs have the primary responsibility.

Potter County Planning/GIS/Community Development Director Will Hunt announced that his department is hosting a series of Community Planning Workshops geared toward borough, township and county officials March 27, April 3 and April 10.
